COVID-19 response

COVID-19 severely impacted people across the globe in terms of personal, social, professional and economic losses. While the pandemic threatened all members of society, persons with disabilities were disproportionately impacted due to attitudinal, environmental and institutional barriers that were reproduced in the COVID-19 response. Our team reached out to wheelchair users and their families during these difficult times through our COVID-19 response:



1,300 wheelchair users & their families received essential food/dry rations kits



130 wheelchair users with spinal cord injuries received essential health supplies



2,000 wheelchair users & their families reached via remote support & advice on physical well-being



400 wheelchair users received virtual repair and maintenance support

235 children & adults with disabilities received the right wheelchair



604 professionals, wheelchair users & their caregivers trained on wheelchair service provision & wheelchair skill training

Leading the way with the right wheelchair

Baby from rural Andhra Pradesh

Baby is an inspiration not just for her family and friends, but also for the students that she teaches at a primary school in rural Andhra Pradesh. A teacher by profession, she makes learning Telugu and Social Studies so much fun for her students. In fact, even during the lockdown, when the classes were shifted to the online mode, she ensured that her students continued to learn and gain the best out of the situation.

Diagnosed with post-polio syndrome at a young age, Baby's dream to study and become a teacher were never limited by her immobility. Baby has been receiving rehabilitation support through our partner organisation District Disability Rehabilitation Center (DDRC), East Godavari, Andhra Pradesh and this provided wings to her dream to be a financially independent individual.

Six year old Divyashree, diagnosed with cerebral palsy has been receiving rehabilitation support through our partner organisation Margadarshi.

Divyashree's father, Gopal, a painter by profession and the sole earner of the family lost his job due to COVID-19. With the help of our donors, supporters and partners, Motivation India provided Divyashree and her family with food kits so that they didn't have to struggle for essential supplies to survive.

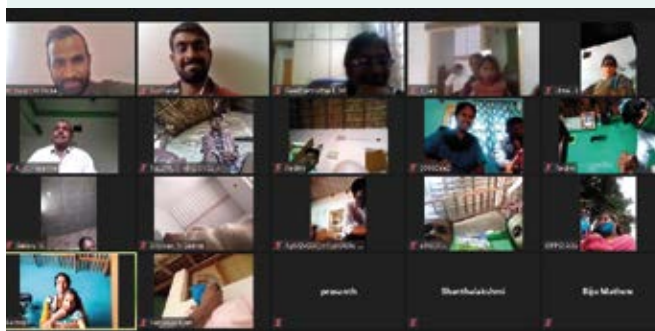


The year 2020-21 challenged us to stretch ourselves more than ever. Wheelchair users were severely impacted due to their dependency on escorts, restricted travel, stress due to uncertainty of education, livelihood and witnessing their dear ones infected with the virus.

At Motivation, we ensured over 3500 vulnerable wheelchair users were supported by essential food/dry ration, health supplies and advice on physical well being as our response to Covid 19.

We worked in 16 states and 4 union territories with 29 partners (both Govt & NGOs). As a result 604 professionals, wheelchair users & their caregivers were trained on wheelchair service provision & wheelchair skill training. We provided 235 children & adults with the right wheelchair as per their individual needs following the WHO Guidelines.

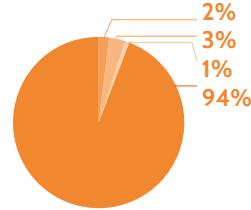

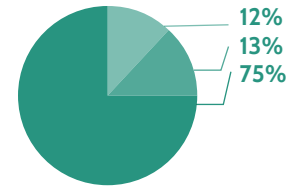
