Motivation India began its operations in 2011. Since then, we have transformed the lives of 16,000+ children and adults with disabilities providing appropriate and customized wheelchairs across 25 states of India through a network of partner NGOs and government bodies.

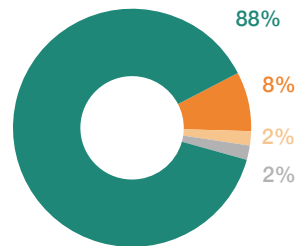

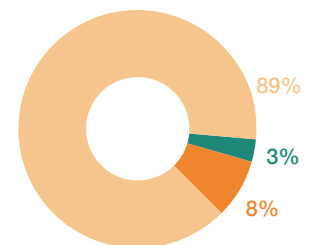
